Regulations on Permission for Admission of Special Auditor as Prescribed in Article 42-3, Item 6 of The University of Tokyo General Rules on College/Faculties

Established on June 27, 2013
Board Resolution
The University of Tokyo Rule No. 14

Article 1 (Permission for Admission)

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Article 42-3, item 6 of The University of Tokyo General Rules on College/Faculties (hereinafter referred to as 'General Rules'), any person other than the dean designated by the President shall be the Director of the Center for Global Education.
2. The Director of the Center for Global Education may grant permission for admission to persons accepted under the university-wide memorandum of understanding concerning student exchange (excluding those administered by individual College/Faculties) concluded in accordance with the Guidelines for the Conclusion of International Exchange Agreements at The University of Tokyo .

Article 2 (Acceptance)

1. The Director of the Center for Global Education shall accept persons who have been granted permission for admission as Special Auditor under the preceding Article in the Center for Global Education.
2. Matters necessary for acceptance shall be separately prescribed by the Director of the Center for Global Education.

Article 3 (Enrollment in Courses)

1. Enrollment in courses and related matters for Special Auditor accepted under these Regulations shall be governed by the General Rules and the provisions established by each College/Faculties and the Center for Global Education.
2. The Center for Global Education and each College/Faculties shall cooperate and coordinate with each other regarding the enrollment in courses and other related matters for Special Auditor accepted under these Regulations.

Article 4 (Interpretation)

For the application of the provisions of the regulations concerning student identification cards and the agreement on the implementation of the regulations on disciplinary action against students with respect to Special Auditor accepted under these Regulations, the term 'Dean' in such provisions shall be read as 'Director of the Center for Global Education'.

Supplementary Provisions

These Regulations shall come into force on June 27, 2013.
These Regulations shall come into force on April 1, 2018.
These Regulations shall come into force on April 1, 2023.
These Regulations shall come into force on April 1, 2024.
